Instructions for your written Candidate Statements

- Please submit your candidate statements, optional video and demographic information to Devin Hogan dhogan@mft59.org and the Election Committee electioncomm@mft59.org **by Friday, April 1st**.
- Please follow this format in written your submission:
 - Name; School Site; Position; Years w/ MPS; Years w/ MFT; Union activities or involvement. (Incumbency will be noted on your profile)
 - Statement length for Presidential candidates is limited to 800 words.
 - All other offices statement lengths are limited to 400 words.
 - A Passport-type photo can be submitted. Head shot only- no words or messages included. JPEG format required.
 - This information needs to be submitted by
 - **Friday, April 1st** for ALL candidates
- This year we would like to provide the opportunity for each candidate to provide video speeches. Keeping with the written format:
 - Name; School Site; Position; Years w/ MPS; Years w/ MFT; Union activities or involvement. (Incumbency will be noted on your profile)
 - Statement length for Presidential candidates is limited to 1.5 minutes.
 - All other offices statement lengths are limited to 1 minute.
 - This information needs to be submitted by
 - **Friday, April 1st** for ALL candidates
- **All candidates will have an opportunity speak** at the respective April membership meetings. Presidential candidates will have 3mins., Officers 2 mins., others 1 min each.

Other Important Information

- The full official election notice and balloting information will be mailed out to all members two weeks prior to the election by our vendor.
- Website profiles for all candidates will be up during the week of April 11th.
